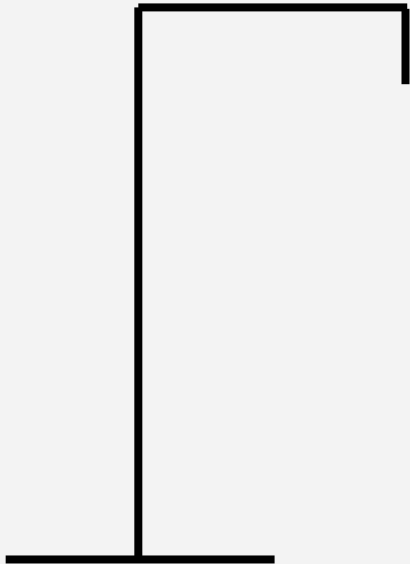
Winter Olympics Sports Hangman

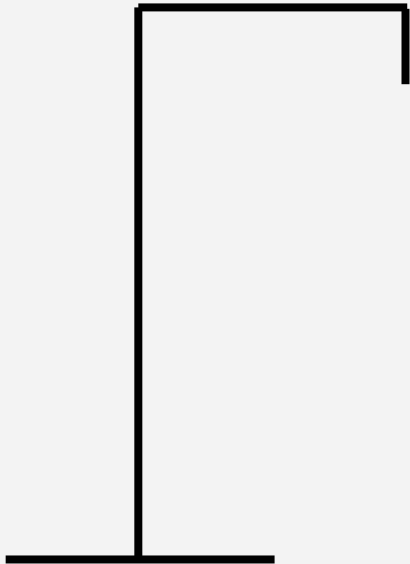

Shaun Roger White (born September 3, 1986) is an American professional snowboarder, skateboarder, and musician. He is a five-time Olympian and a three-time Olympic gold medalist in half-pipe snowboarding. He holds the world record for the most X-Games gold medals and most Olympic gold medals by a snowboarder.

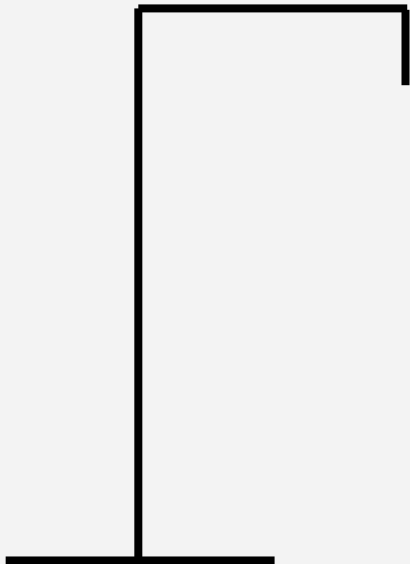

Curling made its Olympic debut at the Winter Olympic Games in Chamonix, France, in 1924 – 74 years before it became an official sport.

What is curling? The team consists of a lead player, who delivers the first two stones, a second, who plays the third and fourth stones, a third, who plays the fifth and sixth stones, and a fourth, who plays the last two stones. Similar to shuffleboard, the aim of the sport is to slide the stones to proper targets on the ice.

Alpine skiing (sometimes referred to as downhill skiing) is one of the signature competitions at the Winter Olympics. Competitors regularly reach speeds of up to 152km/h (95mph), all while navigating a winding course full of sharp turns and soaring jumps. There are 11 events in the Alpine competition at the Games, with 33 medals up for grabs
